

## **Transcript of the online interview 3 with Anuj Kaistha**

Date of interview: 20 April 2019

**Me: Good evening Mr. Kaistha. I have created a plan to create the product and have started working on it. I understand that you would like some improvements and extensions to the product to be added?**

Mr. Kaistha: Currently, because of the lockdown situation, it is hard for all employees to work in the office and so it would be preferable to have some method to work from home.

**Me: I am able to make the database accessible through the internet. Would that suit your needs?**

Mr. Kaistha: That would be great. Please ensure that the interface is able to use online capabilities and allows employees and managers to access the database with full functionality.

**Me: Other than this, are you satisfied with the planning and the current development of the product?**

Mr. Kaistha: Yes, it is looking great! I want to implement this software as soon as possible and that is why I am really looking forward to the completion of the product. However, there is one other improvement that I would want to be implemented. For the office tab, I want to see the office expenses from the start of the month till the current date. For example – Since today is the 20<sup>th</sup>, I would want to see all expenses from the 1<sup>st</sup> till the 20<sup>th</sup> displayed.

**Me: Ok great, I shall implement that to my interface. Is it fine if the office expenses for each office is displayed in the table along with the total cost for the month? The report will be able to compile data from all previous months. However, once the month ends the table will be reset and I will make use of an event scheduler to add that data into another table so it can be used in the report.**
