Through this experience I myself understood that Hindi is actually slowly becoming a "lost" language.


At first i was having trouble in Pronouncing some of the words but the my supervisor helped me and trained me in delivering the dialogues.

This project helped me in being organised and taught me alot about all different global issues we all are facing right now, I became an inquirer and improved my research and presentation skills I took all the facts from the Internet.





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Ann Daan is a food donation drive with the Earth Saviours Foundation, where we created food bags form collecting money and food bags containing non-perishable items to donate to the needy during the 2020 pandemic. Me, Ria, and Rehaan and the whole core team spread the word about the drive and have collected over 600kg of food. The food has been stored in our own houses and will be collecting the bags from the donors soon and a collection team will arrive soon to take the bags and distribute ahead.
